

Kathleen Wheeler PhD, PMHNP-BC, APRN, FAAN is an advanced practice psychiatric nurse and a professor and Director of the PMHNP program at Fairfield University Egan School of Nursing and Health Studies in Fairfield, Connecticut. Dr. Wheeler was co-chair of the National Panel that developed the PMHNP Competencies and the author of an award winning book, *Psychotherapy for the Advanced Practice Psychiatric Nurse: A How-To Guide for Evidence-Based Practice*. She is also the past president and advisory director of the EMDR International Association developed an Integrative Trauma Psychotherapy Certificate Program for licensed mental health professionals at her University. Her awards include induction as a Fellow in the American Academy of Nursing (FAAN); the American Psychiatric Nurses Association (APNA) Media Award; the APNA Excellence in Practice Award; the APNA Excellence in Education Award; the EMDRIA Award for Outstanding Service; and Distinguished Alumni of Cornell University-New York Hospital School of Nursing. Dr. Wheeler is a psychoanalyst and an EMDR Trainer and Consultant with expertise in treating trauma. She has been in private practice providing psychotherapy and prescribing medications since 1984. Recently she chaired the Expert Panel that developed Trauma and Resilience Competencies for Nursing Education which are now copyrighted and available online. She is on the Editorial Board of the *Journal of the American Psychiatric Nursing* as well as on the Editorial Board of *EMDR Journal of Practice and Research*.
